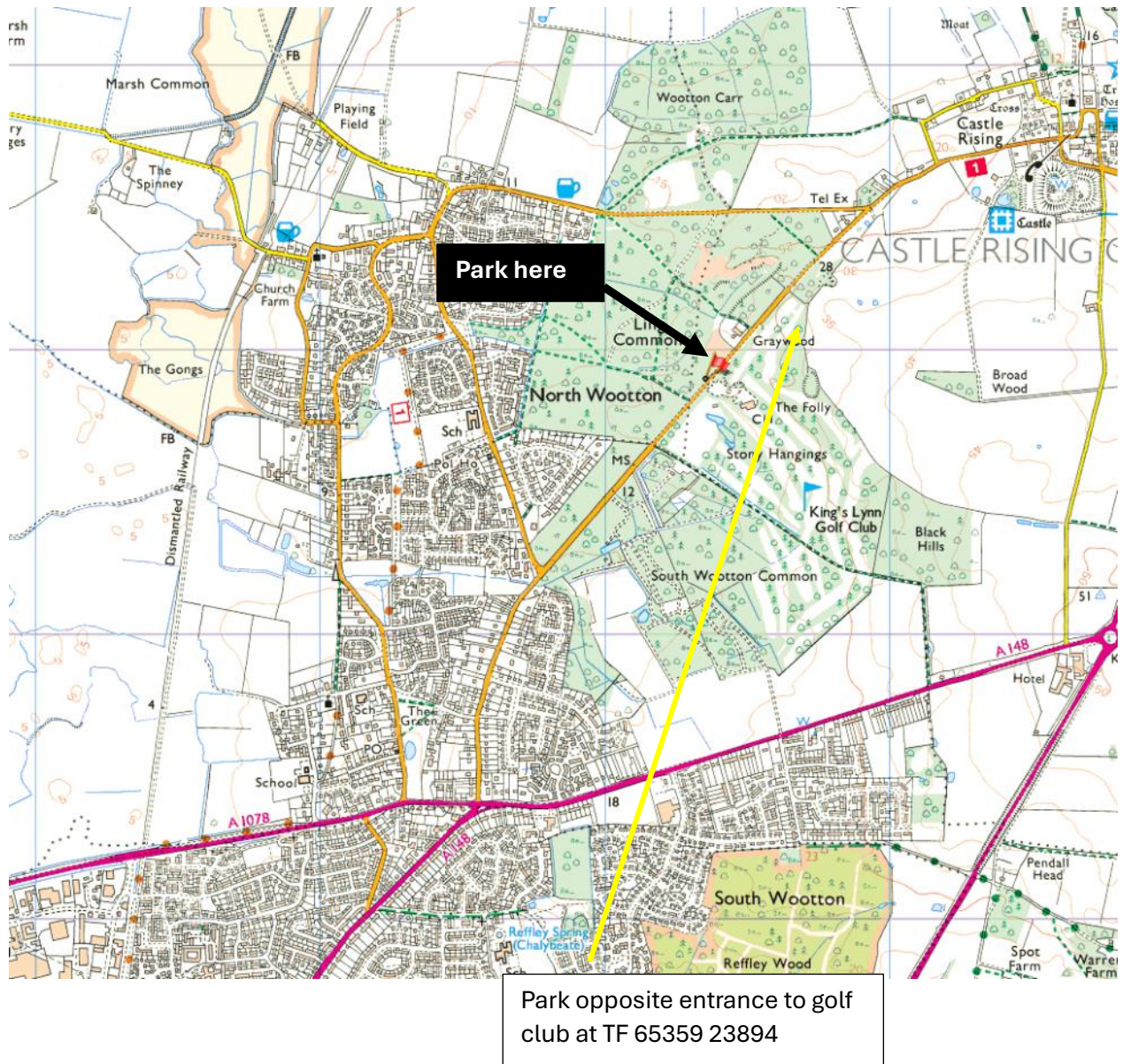


LING COMMON, NORTH WOOTTON, Meet at 10.30 a.m.

### Ling Common, North Wootton, Norfolk

A site well-recorded by Robin Stevenson from late 1980s through to 2015ish. The site covers four monads, two of which (smaller ones) have not been looked at fully since 2011.

Visits have been made recently in 2023/24 and some of the scarcer/interesting species have been re-located; others are still on the list to re-locate. The list here is not exclusive but represents the Nationally Scarce species with some other scarcer species for Norfolk; both re-located and to find.
